Facilities for students

Course offered is of 05 years duration plus 01 year internship training. The curriculum approved by the University of Dhaka and BMDC is strictly followed in the college.

MBBS Course: Phase:1- Duration 18 months.

Preclinical subjects: Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry.

Phase :2 and Phase : 3- Duration - Phase: 2=01 year, Phase:3=01 year.

Para-clinical subjects: Community Medicine, Forensic Medicine, Pharmacology,

Phase:4 - Duration-18 months.

Allied subject Surgery: Orthopedic surgery and traumatology, ENT, Ophthalmology, Anesthesiology, Radiology, Radiotherapy, Dentistry.

Academic activities of all phases are co-ordinated by Phase coordinators and Academic coordinator selected by the Academic Council of the College.

Notes:

- Pathology includes General pathology, Systemic pathology, Hematology, Clinical pathology and Blood Transfusion etc.
- Microbiology includes Bacteriology, Immunology, Virology, Parasitiology and Mycology etc.
- Medicine includes Medicine in general, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Infectious and Tropical diseases, Veneral diseases and Physical Medicines etc.
- Surgery includes General Surgery, Orthopedics Surgery and Traumatology, Ophthalmology Otorhinolaryngology, Anesthesiology, Radiology, Radiotherapy and Dentistry etc.
- 5. Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Neonatology and Family planning etc.





Teaching aids and Methods

Overhead projectors, Multimedia and other audiovisual equipment's are used as teaching aids.

Seminars and symposiums and clinical meetings are organized on regular basis to ensure the acquaintances of students with the latest development in medical science.

The students are generally taught by lectures, clinical demonstrations, tutorials, and practical ward demonstration, seminars, symposiums, workshops, field visits and residential field site training(RFST), demonstration and autopsy.

College examinations and evaluation In-course evaluation

The teachers of individual departments regularly assess student's learning through cards containing topics of concerned subjects.

Card final and assessment examinations are held regularly as per schedule given in academic calendar. Students need to obtain 60% marks to pass any examinations. 75% class attendance is also mandatory for the students.

End-course evaluation

The University of Dhaka conducts four professional examinations for 05 years MBBS course. The professional examinations held twice in May and November each year. Pass marks 60% in each of written, oral, and practical/Clinical examinations separately.

Admission procedure

Admission Criteria: All local candidates selected by the Directorate General of Health Services, through a competitive examination, will be eligible for admission in IMC. Admission will be conducted on first come, first admission basis; while chronology of merit will strictly be followed. Candidates will have to undergo a medical test to prove their physical competency. Students who have passed SSC and HSC or equivalent, having at least GPA 3.5 individually and combined GPA - 9 can apply for admission in MBBS course. Students who have passed HSC or equivalent examination one year before commencing of the session are not eligible to apply. Students with GCE O & A Level or 12th grade should have equivalent certificate from Directorate General of Health Services, Mohakhali, Dhaka. Admission Procedures for Foreign Students: For the foreign students information regarding admission fee, tuition fee, rules & regulations etc. are available in the college website: www.imchbd.com in details. Selection Procedure: The Admission Committee on the basis of central Medical Colleges Admission Test (conducted by the Director General of Health Services, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh) results makes selection of the students. Kean University English as a Second Language Certificate Program

Background

In order to train health manpower to have access to world class education, Kean University, New Jersey, United States of America and International Medical College, Bangladesh joined hands to sign an Agreement of Cooperation on 3 April 2010. The areas of Collaboration are exchanging faculty and students, engaging in joint research projects, fostering the exchange of academic publications and information, and promoting other academic activities for students such as intensive language training, summer camps and institutes, and traditional collaborative degree and certificate programs. As part of these efforts, a collaborative certificate Program on English as a Second Language (ESL)was introduced at IMC.

Objective

The objective of the ESL certificate program is to provide necessary English language skills for health professionals. This would address integrative communication skills, including reading, writing, speaking and listening. This would also provide core competencies for IELTS and TOEFL examinations.

Program Design, Faculty and evaluation

The program is of 16 weeks duration with weekly 3 classes of 2 hrs duration (total 96 hrs). It includes modules for listening, reading, writing, and speaking. Students are taught in small groups; each class comprising of maximum 25 students. There are separate batches for medical and nursing students.

The teachers include Prof. Mark Shryock from School of Global Education & Innovation, Kean University, Ms. Lauren Brianna Millerand Mr. Bernard A MacCann from Canada. Presently Mr. A K M Iqbal Bahar M. A. is conducting the ESL Certificate Program.

The center is equipped with modern audiovisual teaching aids. A good number of books and CDs are available as resource material.

The students undergo pretest and posttest at beginning and end of course respectively. Passing the final evaluation is a prerequisite for obtaining the Kean University Certificate for English as a Second Language.

ESL Certificate Program was inaugurated on July 21, 2012. In each cycle, two separate batches (each comprising 20-25 students) are run simultaneously for 16 weeks. Thus, so far, six cycles have been completed till June 2015.

A total of 196 students (from both medical and nursing programs) have successfully completed the certificate course. Certificate from Kean University, USA is awarded to candidates who complete the course successfully.

As a supplemental approach to the ESL Certificate Program, a TOEFL coaching program was started on May 9, 2013. Here students interested for appearing in TOEFL are given special coaching.

Benefits

ESL certificate has been a rewarding learning activity for the students. The students have been benefited in following ways:

- a) They improved a lot communication skills. Students have shown marked improvement in English usage and confidence.
- b) The program also benefitted them in reading medical texts in English, writing medical reports and papers and exploring the medical information highway through internet.
- C) The students would get advantage in higher education abroad due to better communication and language skills.
- d) The health professionals will be able to deliver service in international level.

In totality the graduates of the course would become different as persons, skilled enough to brace the challenges of modern health professions' education and become a community oriented patient caring health-care service provider.


